Our 7th Tradition: "direct contributions rather than fundraising"

How fundraising evolved?

In looking at this topic, it is helpful to understand how fundraising started in our fellowship.

- * Many early groups held a variety of activities such as dinners, picnics, and other social events to promote recovery, unity, and a sense of belonging.
- + These activities were not specifically intended to raise funds.
- * a number of them turned out to be financially successful, allowing the host group to purchase additional literature or other supplies for their meetings.

- * As the fellowship grew and the need or want for additional services became greater, the purpose of some of these activities changed;
- + Instead of celebrating recovery, they were designed to raise funds.
- + Some service committees began relying on this form of funding,
- The success or failure of an event such as a convention determined the area or region's ability to provide services and participate in the fund flow.

- + they began to put an extraordinary amount of time and effort into these activities, becoming invested in having a "successful" convention, dance, or campout.
- When fundraising starts to seem like the most important thing we're doing, our priorities are out of proportion.
- * It can be very easy for a service body that is funding itself or that is financially dependent on events and conventions, to loose touch with its accountability to the groups."

World services bulletin # 21 revised: "The generation of funds (fundraising) and the 7th Tradition"

If our events begin to take on a greater sense of importance than supporting our groups or reaching addicts in our community, we might want to look at our priorities. We want to ask ourselves whether money is diverting us, whether it is contributing to our unity or our division, and whether we are loosing our sense of purpose.









"When a member places a donation into the basket at a meeting, he or she is breathing life into that group and the NA service structure. That same individual contribution also brings life to the principle of self-support".
